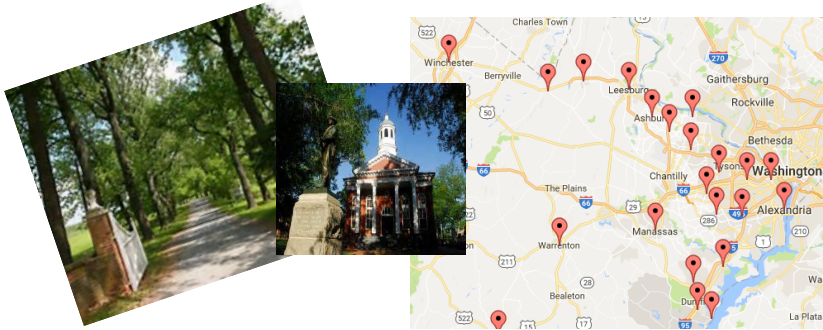

(No toll alternative: Take route 7 west for 14.5 miles, at Route 28 south toward Dulles Airport for 3 miles: at Waxpool Rd/Route 625 exit west/right toward Ashburn for 1.5 miles; hotel is on the right.) From Leesburg: Route 15 take route 7 east for 6 miles; at Loudoun County Parkway/Route 607 right for 6.2 miles; at Waxpool Rd/Route 625 (5th traffic light) right for .4 miles; hotel is on the right.

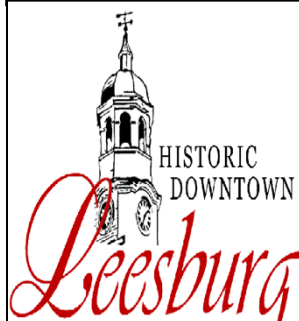
