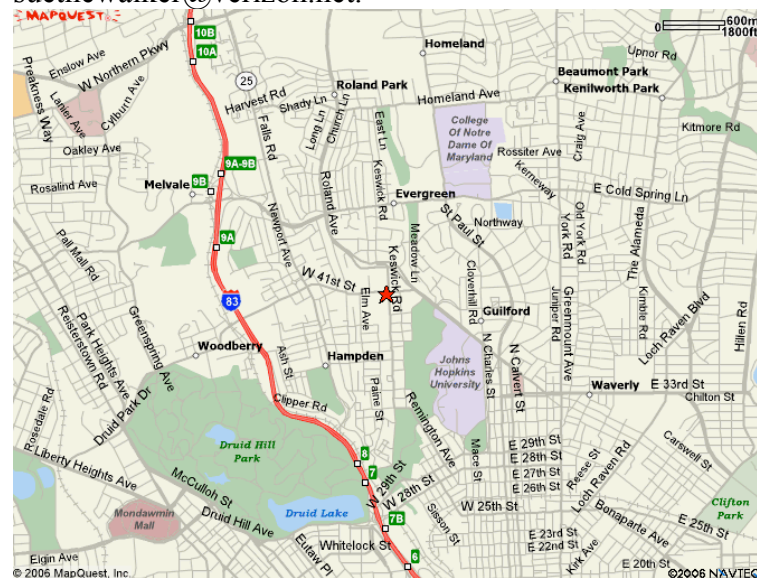
Fees: This event is open to the public and free without AVA credit. AVA credit is \$3.00 per walker.

Conditions: All are welcome to participate, but must register at the start, carry a start card on the walk and turn it in upon completing the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult during the entire walk. All Volkssport participants must sign a disclaimer. A parent or guardian must sign a special athletic waiver for children 17 years old and under before they may participate in a Volkssport event. Children under 12 always walk free at Baltimore Walking Club events. The event will be held in all reasonable weather conditions. If in doubt, contact the person listed on the other side. Pets are welcome, but not in the start point. Pets must be leashed during the entire walk and cleaned up after according to city regulation. Restrooms are available at the start/finish.

Description of the Event: The Woodberry/Hampden area is a study in contrasts. It has the rich history of the mills and foundries that once had a major impact on Baltimore's economy. Much renovation has occurred and there is now a green building development in Woodberry. The Clipper Mills area has been renovated and contains condos, apartments, galleries and shops. The 5 & 10k walks pass "The Avenue" in Hampden. Be sure to allow some time to browse some of the shops there and at Clipper Mills. Restrooms available at the start/finish and along the route.

From 695, the Baltimore Beltway: Take I-83 south to Cold Spring Lane east (Exit 9A). Turn right onto Falls Road (south). Travel slightly less than one mile to 41st St. Turn left; * 41st does a slight jog to the right and becomes 40th St. The Rotunda is on the right side of 40th St between Elm Ave and Keswick Rd. Park behind the Rotunda in the back of the lot in order to leave room for Rotunda business customers who are shopping.

From downtown Baltimore: Take I-83 north to Falls Road (Exit 8). The first light is 36th St. Continue to 41st St. Turn right; 41st does a slight jog to the right and becomes 40th St. Follow directions above *.
