

What is Volksporting? The German term 'volkssport' literally means a 'sport of the people'. Anyone of any age can participate in walking, biking, swimming, or cross country skiing events. These events are not a contest of speed, rather each participant sets their own pace and only needs to complete the event before the stated finish time.

VOLKSMARCH SPONSOR: Princeton Area Walkers, AVA 776

SANCTIONED BY: The American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail is mostly a sidewalk trail along the streets of this historic community. Strollers: easy; Wheelchairs: easy; slight detour around unpaved path: Pets: leashed.

TRAIL BACKGROUND:

Come celebrate Spring on Farnsworth Avenue in Bordentown City with flower, garden and art vendors and exhibitors. Sample menu items from Bordentown's famous Restaurant Row, book a carriage ride through the historic district and enjoy the Annual Franklin Carr Iris Competition. Live music and alfresco dining.

The Iris Festival is named after Franklin E. Carr, a 1936 graduate of William MacFarland High School. He concentrated in horticultural studies at Pennsylvania State University and Rutgers University, and horticulture became his life-long passion. Carr grew hybrid irises that won twelve international awards. Some of his irises can be found in the gardens of Buckingham Palace and the Vatican, and gardens as far away as New Zealand. Festival organizer, Jackie Reed, said Franklin Carr "started his garden on Mary Street and he became world-renowned, so we started the festival in honor of him." REGISTRATION/FEES: Fee for IVV credit is \$3. For non-IVV members we are requesting a \$3 donation to assist in covering our expenses.

FACILITIES: Restrooms available at start point, Bordentown Public Library and other establishments in town.

CONDITIONS: The event will be held unless the festival is cancelled due to bad weather. Please, no littering along the trail. Pets are permitted if leashed.

AWARD: There is no special Award for this event. There is no pre-registration. **This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards.**

EVENT PROCEDURE: At the start point, each participant will receive a start card, which must be filled out legibly with the individual's name and address (preprinted address labels are suggested). The start card must be carried during the event and personally presented at control points along the trail. All cards remain the property of the sponsoring club and must be turned in at the completion of the event.

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone is welcome to participate in the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult along the trail.

IVV RECORD BOOKS: Participants are reminded to bring their IVV record books. Additional books will be available for purchase at \$6 each.

REFRESHMENTS: Water & hard candy will be at start point. There are several restaurants along

Farnsworth St. as well as food vendors participating in this event.

From North Jersey: I-295 South to Exit 57A (Rt. 130). Proceed as from South Jersey.

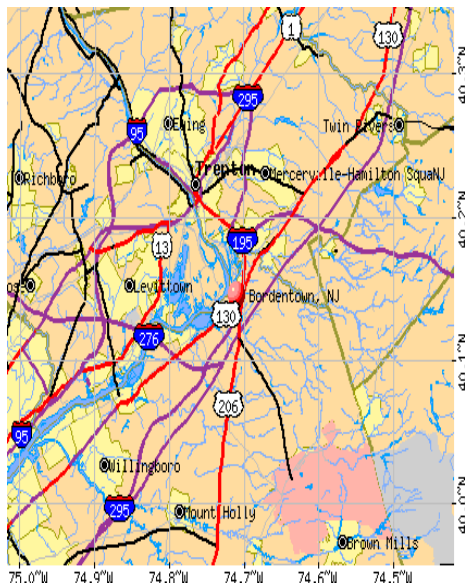
