REGISTRATION/FEES: Fee for IVV credit is \$3. For non-IVV members we are requesting a \$3 donation to assist in covering our expenses.

FACILITIES: Restrooms available at start point, Princeton Public Library, Starbucks and other establishments in town & on Princeton University Campus.

CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions, but keep in mind that severe weather will increase the trail difficulty. Pets are permitted if leashed. There will be no refunds.

AWARD: There is no special Award for this event. There is no pre-registration.

EVENT PROCEDURE: At the start point, each participant will receive a start card, which must be filled out legibly with the individual's name and address (preprinted address labels are suggested). The start card must be carried during the event and personally presented at control points along the trail. Participants missing a control point may be refused an award/or IVV credit. All cards remain the property of the sponsoring club and must be turned in at the completion of the event.

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone is welcome to participate in the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult along the trail.

IVV RECORD BOOKS: Participants are reminded to bring their IVV record books. Additional books will be available for purchase at \$5 each.

REFRESHMENTS: Snack bar in Frist Campus Center, numerous restaurants along Nassau & Witherspoon Streets & many food vendors participating in JazzFeast.

What is Volksporing? The German term 'volkssport' literally means a 'sport of the people'. Anyone of any age can participate in walking, biking, swimming, or cross country skiing events. These events are not a contest of speed, rather each participant sets their own pace and only needs to complete the event before the stated finish time.

Directions: By Car

From the WEST Drive east on Interstate 78 into New Jersey. Exit onto southbound Interstate 287 (toward Somerville). Follow signs for Routes 202/206 south. Go south on 202 for a short distance, follow signs to 206 south, which takes you around a traffic circle. Go south on 206 for about 18 miles to Nassau Street (Route 27) in the center of Princeton. Turn left onto Nassau Street (Route 27), then turn right on Washington Rd. (third traffic light). See directions to parking lot #25 or 5 or 4 .

From the NORTH/New York City Take the New Jersey Turnpike south to Exit 9 (New Brunswick). After the toll booths, take the first right turn onto the ramp for Route 18 north. Soon after you enter Route 18, take the left side of a fork in the road, staying in the right lane. Immediately bear right for an exit to U.S. Route 1 south/Trenton. Drive south on Route 1 for about 18 miles to the Washington Road exit, which is a traffic circle. Take the first right off the circle (between the gas stations) toward Princeton onto Washington Road. See directions to parking lot #25 or 5 or 4.

From South New Jersey We recommend that you take Interstate 295 north (instead of the New Jersey Turnpike). Take Exit 67 to Route 1 north. Travel about 3 miles north on Route 1 to the Washington Road exit, which is a traffic circle. Go three quarters of the way around the circle and turn right (between the gas stations) toward Princeton. See directions to parking lot # 25/ 5 or 4

From the PHILADELPHIA AREA Take Interstate 95 north into New Jersey and exit at Route 1 north (exit 67). Travel about three miles north on Route 1 to the Washington Road exit, traffic circle. Go three quarters of the way around the circle and turn right (between the gas stations) toward Princeton on Washington Rd. See directions to parking lot #25 or 5 . across from tigers in front of PU Football Stadium or 4.

From the EAST Take Interstate 195 west (toward Trenton) to the exit for Interstate 295 north. Drive seven miles to the exit for Route 1 north (exit 67). Travel about three miles north on Route 1 to the Washington Road exit, which is a traffic circle. Go three quarters of the way around the circle and turn right

(between the gas stations) toward Princeton. See directions for parking lot #25 or 5 or 4.

To Parking Lot #25 or 5 or 4 across from tigers in front of PU Football Stadium. Heading north on Washington Road (away from Route 1), turn right onto **Prospect Street**. If you are heading south on Washington Road (away from Nassau Street/Rt 27), turn left onto Prospect Street. Follow Prospect Street and turn right onto Fitzrandolph Road. Make the first right off of Fitzrandolph Road onto Western Way/Ivy Lane. Follow Western Way/Lane and make a right into **Lot 25, 5 or 4. Lot 26 is also available.**

Metered parking is available on Prospect St.

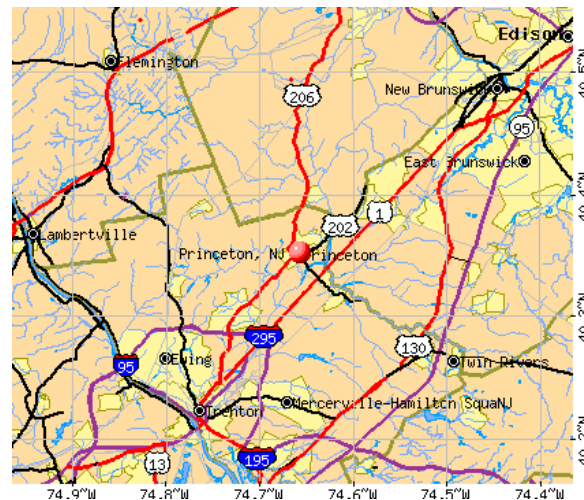
After parking, walk towards tigers in front of the PU Stadium. Make right on Ivy Lane to Washington Road. Cross Washington at the traffic light. Turn right and follow the walkway up the hill along side of the Frist Campus Center. At the top of the hill, turn left and enter the building on the 100 level, and proceed to the Welcome Desk for info & Princeton Area Walkers table OR use side door facing Washington.

Alternative Parking Arrangements Other parking options include municipal parking lots and garages in downtown Princeton. Entrances are located on Chambers Street, Hullfish Street, & Spring Street.
