DIRECTIONS AND MAP:

From South (MD, VA, DC) Take I-79 N to I-70 E to Dunningsville Exit 27, turn left onto Brownlee Rd, go about 3 miles, turn RIGHT onto Rte. 136, follow 136 for about 4 miles, start looking for a sign “Mingo Creek County Park” on the left, turn LEFT onto Sichi Hill Rd. (across from Mingo Inn), at the bottom of hill bear right and take the next RIGHT into the West Entrance of the park.

From West (OH, IL) Take I-70 E. and follow the directions ‘From the South’ from I-70 E to Dunningsville Exit 27 to the park.

From North (Pittsburgh) Take I-79 S. to Exit 9 (Houston/Eighty-Four), turn RIGHT onto Rte. 519 S., go two stop signs, stay on 519 S. to intersection of Rte. 519 & Rte. 136, LEFT onto Rte. 136 E for about 6 mi., turn LEFT onto Sichi Hill Road (across from Mingo Inn), at the bottom of the hill bear RIGHT & take the next RIGHT into the West Entrance to the park.

From East: (NJ, NY) Take I-70 W. merge onto PA-43 Turnpike North (road toll), take Rte. 136 Exit 44 toward Eighty-Four/Monongahela, turn LEFT onto Dry Run Rd/Rte. 136, continue to follow Rte. 136, turn RIGHT onto Sichi Hill Rd (across from Ingo Inn), at the bottom of the hill bear RIGHT and take the next RIGHT into the West Entrance to the park.
