

REGISTRATION: At Rockburn Park West Area Pavillion.

- *No fee to walk the trail without receiving the IVV credit.*
- The participation fee for IVV Credit Only is \$3. (maximum \$10 for families with minor children living together)

PROCEDURE: Each participant will be issued a start card. It must be carried on the walk and presented for validation at each checkpoint. Only one start card will be validated per participant. Start cards must be turned in at the Finish Table after completing the event. Only those participants with a properly validated start card will be eligible for IVV credit. The trail may be walked two times per start card on the same day at no additional cost.

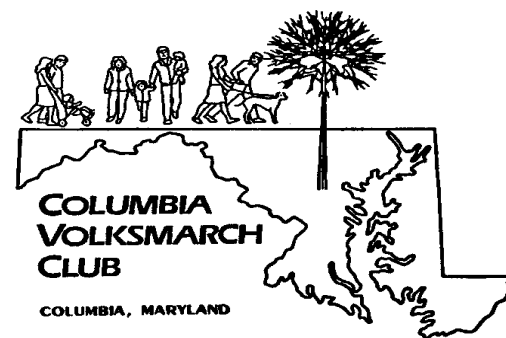

DIRECTIONS:

To Rockburn Branch Park – West Area

6105 Rockburn Branch Park Road, Elkridge
From Rte. 29, take Exit 22 Rt 100 east to Md. 103 exit.
Go around the circle and cross over Rte. 100 –or–
From I-95, take Exit 22 Rt100 W to Rt103 W, Meadowridge Rd
-Then- Proceed through next circle. At the first traffic light,
RIGHT on Montgomery Rd. Proceed to traffic light and
LEFT to remain on Montgomery Rd. Travel about 6/10 mile;
LEFT onto Rockburn Branch Park Rd Proceed about ½ mile
(passing tennis courts). At Triangle (before softball fields),
LEFT uphill to end of road.

Note: Rockburn Branch Park has two entrances. The West entrance is off Montgomery Rd.

TIMES: Start between 8:00am and 11:00am; finish by 2:00pm

CONDITIONS: The event is open to all. The event will be held during all reasonable weather conditions, including rain. Littering along the trails is prohibited. Dogs on leash are permitted on the trail.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS: There is one event with two trails for the walk: a 10km with a shorter 5km option. The trail for each event is mostly on natural park trails and road shoulders within Howard County Parks. Strollers will have difficulty with most trails. None of the trails are suitable for Wheelchairs.
